Among possible areas of activity (depending on country's priorities): popularization of healthy lifestyle, career guidance of schoolchildren about medical professions, popularization of personnel blood donation.

15. Opening of regional (local) offices around the country

Establishing new offices in other cities / regions of the country.

16. Annual National Forum of Medical Volunteers

Organization of a national forum in which coordinators of all regional (local) offices and active volunteers will take part.

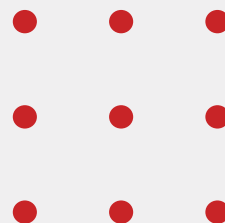


17. Organizing regular meetings with leading activists

Discussing working issues, planning activities, etc.

ROAD MAP

for developing country offices of “Medical volunteers”



1st and 2nd month of activity



1. Search for candidates for the position of country coordinator of the “Medical volunteers” and approval of the candidacy by Movement’s directorate

Distribution of the questionnaire among potential candidates, receipt of completed questionnaires, approval of the candidacy by the Movement’s directorate.



2. Determination of priority areas of activity

Identifying priorities in the healthcare sector of a particular country where volunteers might be needed. Preparing a preliminary action plan.



3. Establishing working relations with medical schools

Conducting presentation meetings with competent officials of medical schools, on the basis of which the establishment of the country office is planned.
Signing of a memorandum of cooperation between the Directorate of the “Medical volunteers” movement and the university.



4. Founding a group of leading activists

Search for active students (4-5 people) who potentially could become the “core” of the country office and take responsibilities as coordinators of medical volunteer activities in their country. Recruitment of volunteers who are ready to assist in areas of medical volunteerism.



5. Conducting video-conferences with the Directorate of the Movement

Sharing the results of country office’s work during the first month. Receiving answers to different questions. Determination of reference points for developing further cooperation.



6. Launch of the first wave of activities

Continuation of the recruitment process. Among possible areas of activity (depending on country’s priorities): providing assistance to the medical personnel, sanitary and preventive education of the population, providing medical assistance during large-scale sport and public events, etc.

the end of the 1st month of activity

starting from the 2nd month of activity

during the 2nd month of activity, later – twice a year



7. Organizing School of Medical volunteers (versions 1.0, 2.0)

Conducting a series of interactive and educational activities aimed at enhancing volunteer motivation to participate in various activities, developing leadership skills and attracting new activists.

8. Conducting a video-conference with the Directorate of the Movement

Sharing results following the second month of activity. Receiving answers to different questions. Determination of reference points for further cooperation.

3rd month of activity



9. Establishing cooperation with medical institutions (hospitals, clinics, etc.)

Organization of presentation meetings for management and staff of medical institutions in order to further develop different areas of activity and increase the number of volunteers.



10. Establishing cooperation with health management authority in the country (official body implementing the state policy in the field of healthcare)

Organization of presentation meetings for the representatives of the Ministry of Health who supervise public and volunteer projects. Explanation about possible areas of activity and potential help provided by the Ministry to volunteers.



11. Establishing cooperation with medical colleges

Organization of presentation meetings for the representatives of medical colleges operating in the country.

the end of the 3rd month of activity. Later – once a month during first 6 months of activity. Afterwards – only if needed.



12. Conducting a video- conference with the Directorate of the Movement

Sharing results following another month of activity. Receiving answers to different questions. Determination of reference points for further cooperation.
